

FTMA Australia 2026 Community Award

The FTMA Community Award recognises businesses within the frame and truss industry that make a meaningful contribution to their local communities. This award celebrates organisations that understand their role extends beyond business operations and actively invest in the people, organisations and initiatives that strengthen the communities in which they operate.

Across Australia, many FTMA members support their communities through sponsorships, volunteering, partnerships with local organisations, and initiatives that promote education, wellbeing and opportunity. These efforts help create stronger, more connected communities while also showcasing the positive impact our industry can have.

Businesses that engage with their communities often become catalysts for local development, supporting schools, sporting clubs, charities, apprenticeships and community programs. These contributions not only improve quality of life locally but also help raise awareness of career pathways and opportunities within the frame and truss industry.

The FTMA Community Award acknowledges those businesses that demonstrate leadership in community engagement, highlighting the important role our industry plays in supporting society.

Award Criteria

To ensure fairness and transparency, nominations for the FTMA Community Award should address the following areas:

1. Local Community Involvement

The nominee should demonstrate active engagement within their local community. This may include sponsoring local organisations, hosting or supporting community events, volunteering, or participating in initiatives that support local development.

2. Initiative or Project Impact

The nomination should outline specific initiatives, programs or projects the business has supported or led. These may include educational programs, environmental initiatives, health and wellbeing campaigns, charity partnerships, apprenticeship programs, or other community-focused activities. Nominations should describe the impact or outcomes of these initiatives.

3. Social Responsibility and Industry Leadership

Nominees should demonstrate a commitment to ethical business practices and social responsibility. This includes maintaining a positive reputation within their community, acting with integrity, and contributing to the wellbeing and sustainability of the community and the broader industry.

How to Apply

To nominate for the FTMA Community Award, please submit a nomination outlining how the business meets the above criteria. The submission should include:

- The business name and contact details
- A summary of the community initiatives or programs supported
- Examples of the impact these initiatives have had within the community
- Any supporting information, testimonials, or references

The more detailed and specific the nomination, the easier it will be for the judging panel to assess the merits of the entry.
